School Uniform September 2023

We are now in a position to give you further details about purchasing our school uniform for the next academic year. The school badge outer ring colour for Year 7 in September will be **PINK**. This will remain with students as they progress through the school. Our uniform supplier is Michael Sehgal and Sons Ltd, and their website address is

<u>www.michaelsehgal.co.uk</u> We have published a presentation from our uniform supplier, which you can access from the transition area of our school website. This provides you with all of the information that you need about ordering school uniform for September 2023.

Using information available from Wynsors' Shoes, we have compiled a brochure of suitable school shoes. This brochure can be found in the Transition area of our website. Please note that there may be some variation in shoe codes, sizes and availability. You are welcome to buy school shoes from any retailer, providing that the shoes purchased match the requirements in our uniform guide and the examples of approved styles in our shoe brochure. (they must be black and polishable).

Transition Days: 12, 13 and 14 July 2023

There will be three transition days for students. On these days, they will spend time getting to know the school, other students, and our staff, before they start with us in September. These transition days will be on <u>Wednesday 12 July, Thursday 13 July and Friday 14 July</u>. There are further details about the transition days in the information leaflet included with this letter. <u>There is also important information that we require from you relating to the transition days as part of the reply slip that needs to be returned to us by Friday 16 June.</u> Students will be required to make the journey to and from school themselves for the transition days, supported by a parent/carer if needed. This is an important step to get children accustomed to travelling to and from school by themselves from September.

I will be writing to you about the arrangements for the start of term again in due course. If you have any questions that are not answered in our transition FAQs section, please complete the contact form in the transition area of the school website with your query, and we will respond to you as soon as possible. We are looking forward to meeting you at our event on **Thursday 22 June** and welcoming your child to Jesmond Park Academy in September for the next exciting stage in their learning journey.

Year 6 students will be invited to spend three full days with us here at Jesmond Park Academy on 12, 13 and 14 July. The days will start at 8:30am (children to arrive for 8:20am) and finish at 3pm. Primary school uniform and trainers should be worn on this day and students should bring their own water/drink and we advise that you provide them with sunscreen.



The day visits to the school will involve sample lessons, a range of activities, and a tour of the school.

For the visits, you will need to make travel arrangements for your child to and from Jesmond Park Academy. We recommend that the children make the journey to and from school independently in preparation for September.

Please note:

- We will provide students with a cereal bar during break time therefore, please indicate on the reply slip if your child has any dietary requirements that we need to be aware of. We have water fountains in school so that students can re-fill their own bottles if needed.
- Your child will need to bring a packed lunch each day. However, a packed lunch will be provided for students who receive Free School Meals. <u>If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, please indicate their preference on the reply slip enclosed</u>.
- You child will need to wear trainers for the three transition days as they will be involved in PE activities on one of the days.
- They will also need to bring a reading book with them on all three days.
