Voice & Influence

The Voice and Influence Team is new and has been formed within the Children, Education and Skills Directorate at Newcastle City Council works to ensure that all children and young people, aged 25 and under, are involved in decisions which impact their lives.

Their work is supported by the Evry project, which is an 8-year plan to help every baby, child and young person be able to live, work, study and thrive in Newcastle. They have monthly Locality Youth Voice sessions to discuss the issues that matter the most to young people in the city.

They work with existing Council services and children in our care, as well as with partners around Newcastle to consult young people on what opportunities they want to see in their local areas and the city as a whole.

Voice & Influence

The Voice and Influence Team have a wide remit which includes:

- Consultation with young people within Newcastle, in person and online.
- Ensuring children and young people have their voices heard by council leaders and decision makers.
- Ensuring children and young people are involved in the recruitment process for all new posts within Children, Education and Skills.
- Allow children and young people to have an influence over their own lives, especially those who are in care, making sure to do what's best for them.
- To ensure every baby, child and young person can live, work, study and thrive in the city.
- To provide support to external agencies and schools regarding youth voice.
