The success of the school is built on a strong knowledge based curriculum, good attendance, excellent teaching and well embedded PRAISE code and routines. Moving up from primary school

Many students first experience Jesmond Park Academy while still at primary school, as we work very closely with all our feeder schools.

We have outstanding working relationships with all primary schools across Newcastle. Students who choose Jesmond Park Academy are well on the road to success before they even start.

From Primary transition through to leaving us at the end of Year 13, Jesmond Park Academy provides a caring, nurturing environment. The transition from primary to secondary school is an important one: it's something all schools do, but not everyone does it as well as us.

We have developed a transition programme that has been recognised both locally and nationally as an example of good practice. We have also been involved in the training of Newcastle University primary PGCE students in effective pupil transition from Year 6 into Year 7.

Students follow the National Curriculum in KS3. They study Maths, English, Science, PE, Computing, Art, Technology, History, Geography, RE, Citizenship/PSHE, Modern Foreign Languages (Spanish, French or Mandarin) Performing Arts (Drama and Dance) and Music. In Year 7 all students follow an accelerated reading programme. In Years 8 & 9 some students have the opportunity to study a second MFL.

Making the best years happen

A great academy is not just about results. At Jesmond Park Academy we take an original approach to ensuring every student feels safe and secure, that they have the confidence and motivation to really get the best from their education, not just academically but socially and culturally.

Inclusion means everyone

Everyone is valued at Jesmond Park Academy. Every student brings something special to our community, whether it be academic success, music and drama, sporting skills, or simple hard work and honesty. We are proud of our provision for children with special needs of all kinds. Staff work hard to make sure each student is engaged and gets the support they need.

Specialist resources

We have a dedicated team of highly qualified SEND teachers and teaching assistants who support students with a range of learning, physical and behavioural special needs, which allows students to access mainstream curriculum lessons. We also have a specialist resource centre for hearing impaired students.

Pastoral support

Our inclusive philosophy is supported by our investment in a strong pastoral team to support your child every step of the way. This includes both a Head of Year and non-teaching Year Manager for every year group, overseen by a Head of Key Stage.

Form Tutors see the students in their care every morning and expert support for those who need it comes from our counsellor, attendance and behaviour specialists and regular drop-ins provided by the school nurse service.

Outstanding opportunities

Jesmond Park Academy staff go that bit further to ensure all of our students enjoy a stimulating experience, whatever year they are in.

We have a wide range of after lesson activities across the curriculum including science, art, music, media, sport, personal adventure and challenge, literature, performing arts, computing and mathematics.

We have strong links with industry, business and enterprise. Students enter national and international challenges, such as Young Engineer of the Year, and we have a number of links with industry where students gain hands on skills even in areas as demanding as scientific research.

We also run numerous trips and visits abroad including Language trips to France and Spain, ski trips to Europe and a Disneyland Paris Music trip.

A great number of our students take part in the National Citizenship Service (NCS) programme. Many of our Year 11 students spend time during the summer holidays learning new skills and giving back to local communities.



Comprehensive choices

Before students begin their GCSE studies, they are carefully guided into subject choices that allow them to maximise their potential. This secures their success and prepares them for transition into the Sixth Form.

We foster the highest levels of aspiration and ambition for all of our students at Jesmond Park Academy. We pride ourselves on preparing our students for life beyond GCSE and A Level. We aim to equip our students with vital skills such as independent learning and employability.



Our curriculum philosophy

Sixth Form

Jesmond Park Academy Sixth Form is one of the most popular Sixth Form centres in the city of Newcastle with over 420 students studying with us.

Year after year, the overwhelming majority of our Year 11 students chose to continue their studies with us and a number of students join us from other schools in Newcastle and beyond.

Jesmond Park Academy currently offers a wide range of A level courses, enabling students to compose a programme of study that meets their individual needs, supporting progression onto the next step beyond the Sixth Form. It doesn't stop with just A Levels. There are BTEC Programmes in IT, Business, Science and Media.

A rich experience

Jesmond Park Academy Sixth Form has its own dedicated, state-of-the-art facilities. These include a library and computer suite, common room and canteen. Our students often say it's more like a university than a school. Which, when you think about it, is how it should be.

We encourage all of our students to participate in our enrichment programme that can include building up hours from a combination of sport, charity projects, contributions to school life and even employment within school to support the staff.

We offer great opportunities for our students to engage with employers, universities and the local community.

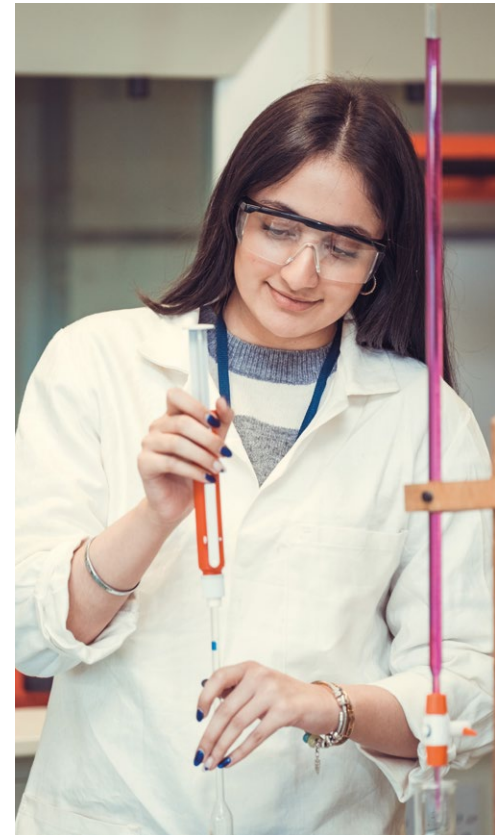
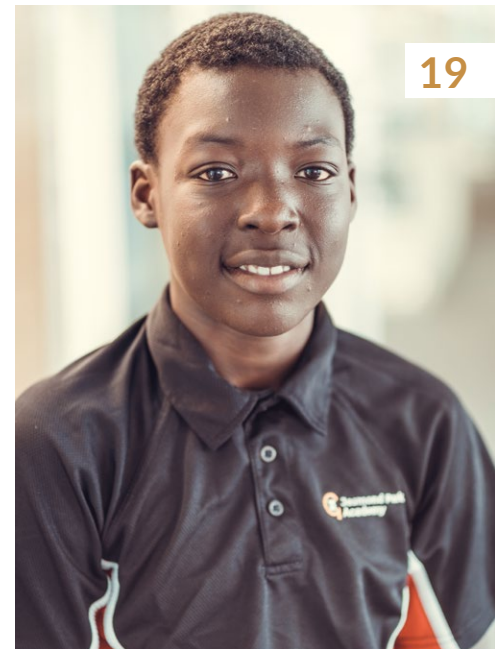

Real progress, exceptional results

Around eight out of ten of our students take up university or college places, with the remaining students going into employment.

The range of university courses that students follow is broad, including Medicine, Veterinary Science, Law, Politics, Engineering and Dentistry to name but a few. Our students go to universities including Oxford, Cambridge and other Russell Group universities. The Russell Group represents 24 leading UK universities. We also have students that have gone to universities abroad, including the USA.
