Year 6 students will be invited to spend two full days with us here at Jesmond Park Academy on 9 and 10 July. The days will start at 8:30am (children to arrive for 8:20am) and finish at 3pm. Primary school uniform and trainers should be worn on this day, and students should bring their own water/drink and we advise that you provide them with sunscreen.



The day visits to the school will involve sample lessons, a range of activities, and a tour of the school.

For the visits, you will need to make travel arrangements for your child to and from Jesmond Park Academy. We recommend that the children make the journey to and from school independently in preparation for September.

Please note:

- Your child will need to bring a packed lunch each day. However, as previously advertised, a packed lunch will be provided for students who receive free school meals if you so require.
- They will also need to bring a reading book with them on both days
- If your child uses an inhaler or epipen, please ensure that they bring one with them.
- If the weather report suggests that it is going to be hot, you might want to consider providing your child with sun cream, a sun hat and a bottle of water. We do have water fountains so they can refill them. Students can drink water only in lessons. Other soft cold drinks can be drunk at breaks and lunchtimes.
